Learning Focus

Literacy:

We learned more letters and keywords the past week. Here are the new letters and words associated with them that we learned:

Uu - up - /u/

li - itch - /i/

We introduced the difference between consonants and vowels and will continue to explore this as we progress.

We wrote our opinions about apples by writing "I like (color) apples." We worked on this together as we focus on the sight words "I" and "like".

We are also working hard to write our first names with one capital letter and the rest lowercase.

Math:

We have been working on our number sense with many number games. We are learning to correctly write numerals. We are exploring patterns, shapes, and graphs.

Other Learning

Your child brought home a paper explaining our ALICE drill discussion we had on Friday. We learned about what to do during an ALICE drill - the most important take away for your child is to stop, listen to their teacher, and follow the directions quickly.
