Learning Focus

Literacy:

We have been listening to many great books about starting school. We are learning features of books including the front cover, back cover, and title page. We are learning what authors and illustrators do. We have been identifying and forming rhymes.

Math:

We are exploring different shapes and sizes. We are learning number formation and the values of numbers.

Procedures:

In the beginning of K we learn many important procedures, expectations, etc. We have learned our classroom rules: Raise your hand to speak. Follow directions quickly and quietly. Listen when someone is talking. Respect yourself, respect others, and respect your school. Be safe. Be honest. Please review these rules with your child at home and help them understand their importance at school.
